Entries open for Pembroke Welsh Corgis, Wednesday, April 12, 2017 at 10 am EDT. **Entries open for all other breeds on Wednesday, April 19, 2017 at 10:00 am EDT.** All entries received before this date will be returned. Entries will be accepted on a first received basis.

Entries close Monday, May 22, 2017 at 6:00 pm, EDT. After this time, entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or substituted.

Entries limited to a total 50 runs/day, test and trial classes combined. Drawing for running order will be made at Secretary's home on Monday, May 22, 2017, at 8:00 PM.

ENTRY FEES

Trial Classes: Course A & B Sheep (\$55/entry) and Course A & B Ducks (\$45/entry)

-The Course A duck arena is about 100' x 50' and runs clockwise as per the diagram in the AKC regs.

-The Course A sheep arena is about 220' x 120' and runs clockwise as per the diagram in the AKC regs.

-Course B Sheep and Ducks will use the minimum outruns as stated in the AKC regulations. In Advanced B sheep, the handler will be unable to see his/her dog from the handler's post as the dog approaches the lift point. Also the distances to the fence line are the minimum allowed for the B Sheep Course.

Test classes: HT, PT (sheep), \$55 per entry

STOCK

Sheep: Mixed breed 5 Sheep per run on Course A and Course B; 3 Sheep per run, test classes. (Value \$250 per head).

Ducks: Mixed breed- 5 ducks per run on both Course A (Value: \$25 per head).

TRIAL SITE will be open from 7:00 AM to 1 hour after the events end. Dogs may not be left overnight. Please bring shade cloths, water, tents, and chairs with you.

DOGS ON GROUNDS: *You are responsible for picking up after your dogs and disposing of*

waste in the proper receptacles. All dogs present must be held on leash or otherwise restricted except when being judged. Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. Un-entered dogs are not allowed in the trial areas.

PLEASE NOTE: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Please be thoughtful of not exposing all other dogs if you think your dogs have been. Proof of up to date rabies vaccination should be available upon request.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 fee to the amount of each returned check.

ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms (whoever may make such errors) and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of

entries after the published closing date. Please type or print clearly and carefully the information on entry forms to eliminate errors.

DECLINED ENTRIES: The Mayflower Pembroke Welsh Corgi Club Inc may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against the aforementioned mentioned club or any official thereof.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event a dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused, by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the Test\Trial, no refund of entries will be made.

ALTERNATE LIST POLICIES: When entry limits are reached, all additional entries received prior to closing will be added to an alternates list. The alternates list will be used to fill vacancies that occur in the drawn running order, with the first available alternate entry replacing the first vacancy in the class entered. In Test Classes, alternates shall be given priority over dogs eligible to be moved- up.

BITCHES IN SEASON will be permitted to run but will be placed at the end of the running order in Test classes and in catalog order for Trial classes. Please notify the Trial Secretary before the beginning of the class if your bitch is in season.

No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same kind of stock under the same judge at any Test or Trial.
